### Long Island Iced Tea £8.95

Created in Long Island, New York, the term "tea" comes from the colour of this cocktail with Vodka, Tequilla, Rum, Gin & Triple Sec Shaken with Lemon, Gomme & Ice  
Topped with Pepsi Cola



### Mojito £6.95

The classic Cuban highball Bacardi, dark rum, mint syrup, fresh lime juice & fresh mint are shaken together and topped with fresh mint, crushed ice and soda



### Cosmopolitan £6.50

Famously the drink of Sex & the City, until "everyone started drinking it" we take Vodka, Triple Sec & Cranberry with a twist of lime & shaken with ice  
Served in a Martini glass, no wonder everyone drinks it



### Rossini Bellini £5.95

Named after 19th century Italian composer Gioachino Rossini, we use Prosecco and fresh strawberry puree to create a refreshing version of this Venetian classic



### Frozen Strawberry Daiquiri £6.95

Supposedly invented by an American mining engineer, named Jennings Cox, Our take on the popular classic with Strawberry puree, fresh lime, Bacardi dark rum and triple sec, blended with ice



### Martini Prosecco £6.25

Martini Bianco, Prosecco, fresh lime and mint garnish, poured over ice in a large copita.



### Espresso Martini £6.50

Created by Dick Bradsell in the late 1980s while at the Brasserie Soho in London for a young lady who asked for something that would, "Wake me up, and then f\*\*\* me up", Tia Maria, Vodka, freshly made Espresso coffee and gomme. Shaken with ice



### Mockito £4.25

Non Alcoholic version of the Cuban classic with Mint syrup, fresh lime, fresh mint, soda and crushed ice



### Pina Colada £7.50

The national drink of Puerto Rico, Pina Colada means strained pineapple. Here we use pineapple chunks, Bacardi, Malibu, Dark Rum, Gomme and Vanilla Ice Cream for our version of this tropical classic



### Shirley Temple £3.50

Apparently made for the famous child actress, who actually hates the drink! Grenadine and ginger ale served over ice with a cherry on top
